

EuLabRPG Newsletter Number 1

The project

The "EUropean LABoratories of Role-Play Gaming to promote school social and emotional culture" - EuLabRPG is a two-year Erasmus+ project (December 2023 - November 2025) aimed at enhancing the mental well-being of secondary and tertiary students aged 13-19. By incorporating Tabletop Role-Playing Games (TRPG) into the school curriculum, the project seeks to equip students with essential emotional and social skills while supporting teachers in creating inclusive and supportive learning environments. Through TRPG activities, students will enhance metacognitive abilities, fostering personal growth and resilience.







RPG Curriculum

The primary outcome is a comprehensive school curriculum to guide schools in integrating Tabletop Role-Playing Games (TRPG) for enhancing student mental health.

RPG Scenarios

The second work package will develop a teacher training curriculum and resources to effectively implement for effective classroom Tabletop Role-Playing Games (TRPGs) in the classroom.

RPG Laboratories

The last work package will focus on piloting and evaluating the project's outcomes. It will involve testing the developed TRPG curriculum and teacher training in realworld school settings, gathering feedback from various stakeholders, and creating a comprehensive handbook to guide future implementation.
